The life of Christ is exemplified by the Sand Dollar -

- A star on top of the shell is a reminder of the Star of Bethlehem that led wise men to the Christ Child.
- Around the star is the outline of an Easter lily, a reminder of the Lord's resurrection.
- The 5 holes represent the 5 wounds of Christ, to his hands, feet and side
- The outline of a poinsettia on the underside represents the Christmas flower
- Breaking open the sand dollar, 5 dove-shaped pieces emerge a symbol of peace and goodwill.
